### Greyhound Adoption of Ohio

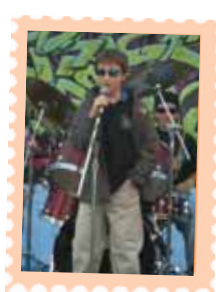

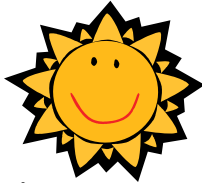
